Share something about your family that you are thankful for. Tell why.

Share something that you are thankful for about someone at your table.

How to Prepare and Enjoy Table Talk Questions!

TO PREPARE

- 1. Print** the two Table Talk question pages and the Suggestion page.
- 2. Cut** the Table Talk question pages into strips, one question per strip.
- 3. Roll** each strip and secure the roll with a paper clip.
- 4. Bowl:** Put the paper “question rolls” in a small bowl. On Thanksgiving Day place the bowl on your Thanksgiving table.

TO ENJOY

Select and Read: Have one person select a paper roll from the bowl and read the question on the paper out loud.

Answer Question: Have the person who drew the paper roll answer the question drawn. Then encourage other family members to share answers they have to the question as well.

Pass Bowl: Pass the bowl to the next person and repeat.

Note: These questions can be enjoyed throughout your Thanksgiving dinner! A new question can be drawn and answered whenever you feel your family is ready. Or, you may like to use these questions throughout Thanksgiving week.
